We continue to be thinking of you all!

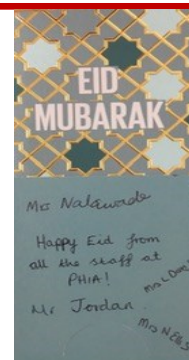
Suggested learning activities: 'Amazing Bodies'
